New Heights Building Closure

After much deliberation, we have reluctantly made the decision to close all sites due to the COVID-19 outbreak. As of 4pm Friday 20th February, all groups will cease until further notice and services will run remotely (via telephone, email or WhatsApp video chat).

We will be reviewing the current situation at the beginning of April and make a decision on reopening by Tuesday 14th (April). As with closure, reopening will depend on government advice and guidance.

Our Breathe, Counselling and St Johns telephone numbers have been diverted to ensure that we are still able to offer information, support and guidance to the local community. Should you require an appointment with our counselling service or Breathe benefits advice or housing service, please call the usual numbers (see below).

This is an extremely unpleasant time for everyone, with daily uncertainties and unexpected changes. Whilst we can, we will continue to operate services to the best of our ability.

We will continue to regularly update our social media pages to ensure that we provide regular updates in respect of service delivery and developments.

We would like to remind everyone to stay safe during this uncertain time and where possible look after each other. We look forward to seeing you all when we are back.
